

## ANNEX TO THE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Denmark

The following annex is part of the general terms and conditions that govern all online offers, sales and purchases through the website(s) currently located at <https://kronaby.com> (together with any successor site(s), the "**Site**").

### **1 DEFINITIONS**

1.1 The following terms and expressions shall have the following meaning:

- a. **WEEE Directive:** means Directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2012 on waste electrical and electronic equipment;
- b. **WEEE or waste electrical and electronic equipment:** means waste electrical or electronic equipment as defined in article 3 (1)(e), being "waste within the meaning of Article 3(1) of Directive 2008/98/EC, including all components, sub-assemblies and consumables which are part of the product at the time of discarding, as implemented under Danish law in section 3(1)(2) of the statutory order on electronic waste;
- c. **EEE or electrical and electronic equipment:** means electrical or electronic equipment as defined in article 3 (1)(a) of the WEEE Directive, being " equipment which is dependent on electric currents or electromagnetic fields in order to work properly and equipment for the generation, transfer and measurement of such currents and fields and designed for use with a voltage rating not exceeding 1 000 volts for alternating current and 1 500 volts for direct current", as implemented under Danish law in section 3(1)(10) of the statutory order on electronic waste;
- d. **Household WEEE:** means WEEE from private households as defined in article 3(1)(h) of the WEEE Directive being "the WEEE from private households and the WEEE which comes from commercial, industrial, institutional and other sources which, because of its nature and quantity, is similar to that from private households. Waste from EEE likely to be used by both private households and users other than private households shall in any event be considered to be WEEE from private households; are qualified as professional WEEE the other WEEE", as implemented under Danish law in section 3(1)(5) of the statutory order on electronic waste;
- e. **Producer:** means any natural or legal person as defined in article 3(1)(f) of the WEEE Directive, as implemented under Danish law in section 3(1)(29) of the statutory order on electronic waste, i.e. the ML Client;

- f. **Distributor:** means any natural or legal person as defined in article 3 (1)(g) of the WEEE Directive, and as implemented under Danish law in section 3(1)(9) of the statutory order on electronic waste, being: "any natural or legal person in the supply chain, who makes an EEE available on the market." i.e. the ML Client;
- g. **Danish WEEE Regulation:** means
  - i. Law no. 87 of 28 January 2014 "Om ændring af lov om miljøbeskyttelse (Gennemførelse af direktivet om affald af elektrisk og elektronisk udstyr (WEEE), gebyrfinansiering af indsamleruddannelsen, digital indberetning på dækordningen m.v.)" implementing the WEEE Directive in The Danish Environmental Protection Act;
  - ii. The statutory order on electronic waste: "Bekendtgørelse nr. 130 af 6. februar 2014 om at bringe elektrisk og elektronisk udstyr i omsætning samt håndtering af affald af elektrisk og elektronisk udstyr";
  - iii. The statutory order on transborder movement of used electronic equipment: "Bekendtgørelse nr. 132 af 6. februar 2014 om overførsel af affald og overførsel af brugt elektrisk og elektronisk udstyr".

## 2 SCOPE OF INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

2.1 The information set out below applies to EEE as follows:

- a. from 13 August 2012 to 14 August 2018 to EEE falling within the categories set out in Annex I of the WEEE Directive (implemented in annex 1 of the statutory order on electronic waste). Annex II of the WEEE Directive (implemented in annex 2 of the statutory order on electronic waste) contains an indicative list of EEE which falls within the categories set out in Annex I of the WEEE Directive and annex 1 of the statutory order of electronic waste. This includes amongst others:
  - i. Large household appliances
  - ii. Small household appliances
  - iii. IT and telecommunications equipment
  - iv. Consumer equipment and photovoltaic panels
  - v. Lightning equipment

- vi. Electrical and electronic tools (with the exception of large-scale stationary industrial tools)
  - vii. Toys, leisure and sports equipment
  - viii. Medical devices (with the exception of all implanted and infected products)
  - ix. Monitoring and control instruments
  - x. Automatic dispensers
- b. from 15 August 2018 to all EEE, unless excluded in article 2 (3) of the WEEE Directive (implemented in section 2(1) of the statutory order on electronic waste).

### **3 INFORMATION FOR USER OF THE EEE**

- 3.1 Pursuant to section 48 of the statutory order on electronic waste the Producer and Distributor are required to provide end users of EEE for private households with the following information in sales- and information material, instructions for use or at the point of sale:
- a. the requirement not to dispose of WEEE as unsorted municipal waste and to collect such WEEE separately;
  - b. the return and collection systems available to users, encouraging the coordination of information on the available collection points irrespective of the producers or other operators which have set them up;
  - c. the possibilities for re-use, recycling and other forms of recovery of WEEE;
  - d. the potential effects on the environment and human health as a result of the presence of hazardous substances in EEE;
  - e. the crossed-out wheeled bin symbol and its meaning;
