

ANNEX TO THE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

FRANCE

The following annex is part of the general terms and conditions that govern all online offers, sales and purchases through the website(s) currently located at <https://kronaby.com> (together with any successor site(s), the "**Site**").

1 DEFINITIONS

1.1 The following terms and expressions shall have the following meaning:

- a. **WEEE Directive:** means Directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2012 on waste electrical and electronic equipment;
- b. **WEEE or waste electrical and electronic equipment:** means waste electrical or electronic equipment as defined in article 3 (1)(e) being "waste within the meaning of Article 3(1) of Directive 2008/98/EC, including all components, sub-assemblies and consumables which are part of the product at the time of discarding"; as implemented under French law in Article R. 543-172 I of the French environmental code.
- c. **EEE or electrical and electronic equipment:** means electrical or electronic equipment as defined in article 3 (1)(a) of the WEEE Directive, being " equipment which is dependent on electric currents or electromagnetic fields in order to work properly and equipment for the generation, transfer and measurement of such currents and fields and designed for use with a voltage rating not exceeding 1 000 volts for alternating current and 1 500 volts for direct current" ; as implemented under French law in Article R. 543-172 I of the French environmental code.
- d. **Household WEEE:** means WEEE from private households as defined in Article 3(1)(h) of the WEEE Directive being "the WEEE from private households and the WEEE which comes from commercial, industrial, institutional and other sources which, because of its nature and quantity, is similar to that from private households. Waste from EEE likely to be used by both private households and users other than private households shall in any event be considered to be WEEE from private households; are qualified as professional WEEE the other WEEE", as implemented under French law in Article R543-173 of the environmental code;
- e. **Producer:** means any natural or legal person as defined in article 3 (1)(f) of the WEEE Directive and as implemented under French law in Article R. 543-174 I. - 1° of the French environmental code,

- f. **Distributor:** means any natural or legal person as defined in article 3 (1)(g) of the WEEE Directive, and as implemented under French law in Article R. 543-174 I.-2° of the French environmental code, being: "any natural or legal person in the supply chain, who makes an EEE available on the market."
- g. **French WEEE Regulation** means the provisions implementing WEEE Directive in the French environmental code (Article R. 543-172 and subs.).

2 SCOPE OF INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

2.1 The information set out below applies to EEE as follows:

- a. from 13 August 2012 to 14 August 2018 to EEE falling within the categories set out in Annex I of the WEEE Directive and in Article R. 543-172 of the French environmental code. Annex II of the WEEE Directive contains an indicative list of EEE which falls within the categories set out in Annex I. This includes amongst others:
 - Large household appliances
 - Small household appliances
 - IT and telecommunications equipment
 - Consumer equipment and photovoltaic panels
 - Lighting equipment
 - Electrical and electronic tools
 - Toys, leisure and sports equipment
 - Medical devices
 - Monitoring and control instruments
 - Automatic dispensers
- b. from 15 August 2018 to all EEE, unless excluded in article 2 (3) of the WEEE Directive and in Article R. 543-172-1 of the French environmental code.

3 INFORMATION FOR USER OF THE EEE

3.1 Pursuant to Article R. 543-187, the Producer and the Distributor are required to take all the appropriate measures to inform the household EEE users about:

- a. the requirement not to dispose of WEEE as unsorted municipal waste and to collect such WEEE separately ;
- b. the return and collection systems available to users, encouraging the coordination of information on the available collection points irrespective of the producers or other operators which have set them up ;
- c. the role of the user in contributing to re-use, recycling and other forms of recovery of WEEE;
- d. the possibilities for re-use, repair, recycling and other forms of recovery of WEEE ;
- e. the potential effects on the environment and human health as a result of the presence of hazardous substances in EEE;
- f. the crossed-out wheeled bin symbol and it's meaning:



- 3.2. According to Article L. 541-10-2 of the French environmental code, the Producer and the Distributors of households EEE are required to provide information on the cost corresponding to the take back and recycling of household EEE they put on the market. The information on the visible fee corresponding to the cost of the WEEE management must be made available “in case of distance selling, by any suitable mean”. In addition, the visible fee has to be clearly written on the end user’s sales invoice.
