

ANNEX TO THE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

GREECE

The following annex is part of the general terms and conditions that govern all online offers, sales and purchases through the website(s) currently located at <https://kronaby.com> (together with any successor site(s), the "Site").

1 DEFINITIONS

1.1 The following terms and expressions shall have the following meaning:

- a. **WEEE Directive:** means Directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2012 on waste electrical and electronic equipment;
- b. **WEEE or waste electrical and electronic equipment:** as defined in article 3(1)(e) of the Greek WEEE Regulation [implementing article 3(1)(e) of the WEEE Directive], means waste electrical or electronic equipment "as further defined in article in article 11(1) of Law 4042/2012, including all components, sub-assemblies and consumables which are part of the product at the time of discarding";
- c. **Household WEEE:** means WEEE from private households as defined in Article 3(1)(h) of the WEEE Directive being "the WEEE from private households and the WEEE which comes from commercial, industrial, institutional and other sources which, because of its nature and quantity, is similar to that from private households. Waste from EEE likely to be used by both private households and users other than private households shall in any event be considered to be WEEE from private households", as implemented in Greece in article 3(1)(h) of the Greek WEEE Regulation;
- d. **EEE or electrical and electronic equipment:** means electrical or electronic equipment as defined in article 3(1)(a) of the WEEE Directive, being "equipment which is dependent on electric currents or electromagnetic fields in order to work properly and equipment for the generation, transfer and measurement of such currents and fields and designed for use with a voltage rating not exceeding 1000 volts for alternating current and 1500 volts for direct current", as implemented in Greece in article 3(1)(a) of the Greek WEEE Regulation;
- e. **Producer:** means any natural or legal person, as defined in article 3(1)(f) of the WEEE Directive and as implemented in Greece in article 3(1)(f) of the Greek WEEE Regulation, that:
 - (i) is established in Greece and manufactures EEE under his own name or trademark, or has EEE designed or manufactured and markets it under his name or trademark within the Greek territory;

- (ii) is established in Greece and resells within the Greek territory, under his own name or trademark, equipment produced by other suppliers, a reseller not being regarded as the 'producer' if the brand of the producer appears on the equipment, as provided for in point (i);
- (iii) is established in Greece and places on the market on a professional basis EEE from a third country or from another EU Member State; or
- (iv) sells EEE in Greece by means of distance communication directly to private households or to users other than private households and is established in another Member State or in a third country.

i.e. the ModusLink Client;

- f. **Distributor:** means any natural or legal person as defined in article 3(1)(g) of the WEEE Directive and as implemented in Greece in article 1(3)(g) of the Greek WEEE Regulation, being "any natural or legal person in the supply chain, who makes an EEE available on the market";
- g. **Greek WEEE Regulation:** means the regulation implementing the WEEE Directive in the Greek Disposed Electrical and Electronic Equipment Regulation [i.e. the Ministerial Decision 23615/651/E.103 (Gov. Gaz. B' 1184/09/05/2014)].

2 SCOPE OF INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

2.1 The information set out below applies to EEE as follows:

- a. from 13 August 2012 to 14 August 2018 to EEE falling within the categories set out in Annex I of the WEEE Directive (as implemented in Annex I of the Greek WEEE Regulation), taking into account Annex II of the WEEE Directive (as implemented in Annex II of the Greek WEEE Regulation), which contains an indicative list of EEE which falls within the categories set out in Annex I [see article 2(1)(a) of the Greek WEEE Regulation]. This Annex I includes the following product categories:
 - Large household appliances
 - Small household appliances
 - IT and telecommunications equipment
 - Consumer equipment and photovoltaic panels
 - Lighting equipment
 - Electrical and electronic tools (with the exception of large-scale stationary industrial tools)

- Toys, leisure and sports equipment
 - Medical devices (with the exception of all implanted and infected products)
 - Monitoring and control instruments
 - Automatic dispensers
- b. from 15 August 2018 to all EEE, unless excluded in articles 2(3) and 2(4) of the WEEE Directive, as implemented in articles 2(2) and 2(4) of the Greek WEEE Directive [see article 2(1)(b) of the Greek WEEE Regulation].

3 INFORMATION FOR USER OF THE EEE

Users of EEE in private households may request information on:

- a. the requirement not to dispose of WEEE as unsorted municipal waste and to collect such WEEE separately;
- b. the return and collection systems available to users, encouraging the coordination of information on the available collection points irrespective of the producers or other operators which have set them up;
- c. the role of the user in contributing to re-use, recycling and other forms of recovery of WEEE;
- d. the potential effects on the environment and human health as a result of the presence of hazardous substances in EEE;
- e. the possibilities for re-use, repair, recycling and other forms of recovery of WEEE
- f. the crossed-out wheeled bin symbol and it's meaning:
