

ANNEX TO THE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SLOVAKIA

The following annex is part of the general terms and conditions that govern all online offers, sales and purchases through the website(s) currently located at <https://kronaby.com> (together with any successor site(s), the "Site").

1 DEFINITIONS

1.1 The following terms and expressions shall have the following meaning:

- a. **WEEE Directive:** means Directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2012 on waste electrical and electronic equipment;
- b. **WEEE or waste electrical and electronic equipment:** means waste electrical or electronic equipment as defined in article 3 (1)(e) as implemented by Section 32 (6) of the Waste Act, being "waste within the meaning of Article 3(1) of Directive 2008/98/EC, including all components, sub-assemblies and consumables which are part of the product at the time of discarding";
- c. **EEE or electrical and electronic equipment:** means electrical or electronic equipment as defined in article 3 (1)(a) of the WEEE Directive as implemented by Section 32 (5) of the Waste Act, being " equipment which is dependent on electric currents or electromagnetic fields in order to work properly and equipment for the generation, transfer and measurement of such currents and fields and designed for use with a voltage rating not exceeding 1 000 volts for alternating current and 1 500 volts for direct current" ;
- d. **Household WEEE:** means WEEE from private households as defined in Article 3(1)(h) of the WEEE Directive as implemented by Section 32 (7) of the Waste Act being "the WEEE from private households and the WEEE which comes from commercial, industrial, institutional and other sources which, because of its nature and quantity, is similar to that from private households. Waste from EEE likely to be used by both private households and users other than private households shall in any event be considered to be WEEE from private households";
- e. **Producer:** means [any natural or legal person as defined in article 3 (1)(f) of the WEEE Directive as implemented by Section 32 (16) of the Waste Act] [or] [name Producer, such as ML Client]
- f. **Distributor:** means any natural or legal person as defined in article 3 (1)(g) of the WEEE

Directive as implemented by Section 32 (20) of the Waste Act , being: "any natural or legal person in the supply chain, who makes an EEE available on the market."

- g. **Waste Act:** means the Slovak Act No. 79/2015 Coll. on Waste, as amended.

2 SCOPE OF INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

2.1 The information set out below applies to EEE as follows:

- a. from 13 August 2012 to 14 August 2018 to EEE falling within the categories set out in Annex I of the WEEE Directive as implemented by Annex 6 (I) to the Waste Act. Annex II of the WEEE Directive contains an indicative list of EEE which falls within the categories set out in Annex I. This includes amongst others:

- Large household appliances
- Small household appliances
- IT and telecommunications equipment
- Consumer equipment and photovoltaic panels
- Lighting equipment
- Electrical and electronic tools
- Toys, leisure and sports equipment
- Medical devices
- Monitoring and control instruments
- Automatic dispensers

- b. from 15 August 2018 to all EEE, unless excluded in article 2 (3) of the WEEE Directive as implemented by Section 32 of the Waste Act.

3 INFORMATION FOR USER OF THE EEE

- 3.1 Please note that some of the products purchased through the Site may be regarded as WEEE after the end of their life-cycle. Please further note that under the WEEE Directive as implemented by the Waste Act it is not permitted to dispose of WEEE as unsorted municipal waste and separate collection of WEEE is required. Under Section 34 in conjunction with Section 37 of the Waste Act, Producer and Distributor shall ensure that the system of return a collection of WEEE is available to the customers and that the customers are informed about its existence upon the sale of the respective product. Details about such return and collection system applicable to the respective products may be

found at the Site. Products that are subject to the return and collection system are marked with the following symbol:



- 3.2 Furthermore, under the said Sections of the Waste Act, the Producer is required to indicate on the packaging or label of the products or at the sales invoice the recycling fee to cover costs of collection, transport and processing of Household WEEE. The Distributor is then required to inform about same upon sale of the respective product. Such recycling fee shall not exceed the best estimate of the actual costs incurred. The amount of such fee with regard to respective products may be found at the Site.
